When emergencies happen, CERT members can give critical support to first responders and provide immediate assistance to victims at a disaster site.

CERT is a twenty-hour training program that prepares you to help yourself, family, neighbors, and co-workers in the event of a disaster. To receive a class completion certificate you must attend all twenty hours of training.
