## **COVID-19 KNOWN AS NOVEL CORONAVIRUS:**

Mason County has thirty-three (33) total confirmed cases of COVID-19, six (6) cases are active, with one (1) COVID-19 related death from Mason County at the time of this release.

## **WASHINGTON COUNTIES SAFE START STATUS:**

- **Mason County** is still <u>in phase one</u> of the Safe Start reopening process. Our County is finalizing our proposed plan and documentation to apply to move to phase II.
- Counties approved to move to Phase II: Asotin, Columbia, Garfield, Lincoln, Ferry, Pend Orielle, Skamania, Stevens, Wahkiakum, and Whitman
- Eligible to submit a variance application: Adams, Clallam, Clark, Cowlitz, Grant, Grays Harbor, Island, Jefferson, Kitsap, Lewis, Mason, Pacific, San Juan, Spokane, and Thurston.
