# North Mason Regional Fire Authority (NMRFA) Meeting Minutes 460 NE Old Belfair Hwy 4/10/2018

Present: Commissioners McIntosh, Kewish, Quigley, Miller, Severson; Executive Assistant Patti, Chief

Bakken; Assistant Chief Cooper **Guests:** Cpt. Jeromy Hicks

Meeting minutes from March 13<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> and were presented for approval.

Commissioner Severson moved to approve the meeting minutes as presented. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion. Motion approved.

**Vouchers**- Vouchers for the month of April #1804001 to #1804063 in the amount of \$111,909.25 were presented for approval. There will be a second batch presented at next week's meeting that will include payroll and any additional invoices that may come in between now and then.

Commissioner Kewish moved to approve the vouchers as presented; Commissioner Severson seconded the motion. Motion approved.

FINANCIAL REPORT: Chief Bakken will present the financials at next month's meeting.

#### **ADMINISTRATION REPORT:**

**Station Security Update:** Cpt. Hicks reported a contract was signed with the company Intelli Systems; they will be out this week to do a walk thru of Station 21 and 27. We will be doing the door security and window tinting. He anticipates this time next month we will have some systems in place to show the Board.

**Department of Ecology:** We were awarded a \$12,500 Department of Ecology Grant. Kudos was given to FF Anthony Rhead who did the work to get this grant for the Authority. We are appreciative of his work. This grant is for foam, clean up pads etc.

**Opiate Stakeholder Meeting:** Chief Bakken shared that the Stakeholder group is researching obtaining  $1/10^{th}$  of 1% monies for our area and they will be establishing Patient Coordination. Commissioner Quigley remarked on an article she read in the Kitsap Sun about a group that is involved with Opioid crisis. This would be beneficial to obtain and read.

**Highway 3 Roundabout:** Mason Transit will be building a transit center off of Log Yard Road. There are three options for traffic flow being discussed. Those options include a round-a-bout, traffic lights and turn lanes. The Authority has participated in meetings but has not taken a position on this topic. We will share additional details as they are released.

**Training Burn:** A training burn will occur on Saturday, May 19<sup>th</sup> on North Shore Road. This building is much smaller than the previous burn and therefore we will only involve individuals from the Authority.

**Region 9 Spring Meeting:** This event is coming up on April 14<sup>th</sup> and is being held in Grapeview at MCFD3's Station. Commissioners McIntosh, Kewish, and Quigley will be in attendance. Chief Bakken will be presenting on the opioid epidemic.

**IMS Implementation:** AC Cooper shared that ITAC Train the Trainer is taking place this weekend. The Captains and Chief will be in attendance.

**NFA Command and Control Class:** AC Cooper provided an update on the six day long class that took place last week. This course is typically offered at the National Fire Academy in Maryland and occasionally in settings like this. There were numerous agencies in attendance. He thanked those who helped cover for individuals who attended.

**Sexual Harassment Policy:** Chief Bakken reported work is still being done to update this policy. We are working to align the policy language in accordance with what our insurance group recommends.

**Retention Committee:** The group met after the Commissioner meeting last month. There was discussion on bringing volunteers into the conversation. AC Cooper spoke to the three Volunteer Captains who expressed interest in taking an active part in the discussions. Initially the Union paid for the entire study, Commissioner Severson recommended we pay for ½ the cost of the survey to be fair. He believes we are in a good place in the organization.

Commissioner Miller made a motion for the Authority to pay ½ the cost of the survey as presented; Commissioner Quigley seconded the motion. Motion approved.

**Refurbishment of 2003 Medic Unit:** We are seeking to refurbish one of our short box medic units. The work would include a re-chassis and box upgrade. AC Cooper thanked members of the vehicle spec committee (PM Cloud, FF Rhead and PM Fulkerson) for their hard work on this project. We are recommending we go out to bid to have the service completed.

Commissioner Kewish made a motion to go out to bid as presented; Commissioner Severson seconded the motion. Motion approved.

Commissioner McIntosh requested the Board receive an updated replacement schedule for vehicles.

**Minitor IV (Radio Pager) Surplus Request:** We are requesting formal surplus of several outdated and obsolete Minitor IV Pagers. A surplus list is attached for review. Chief Bakken reported there is a secondhand market for these pagers so we will see if we can recoup costs.

Commissioner Quigley made a Motion to formally declare the items surplus as presented; Commissioner Kewish seconded the motion. Motion Approved.

**Target Solutions:** The Board was taken thru a demo of the training platform we use called Target Solutions. The Board was assigned the Sexual Harassment training module to complete. There was

discussion on what could go on the site. Chief cautioned against putting things on the site so to avoid a public meeting.

**Executive Assistant Pay:** Chief Bakken made a request of the Board to set up a two person conversation committee with EA Patti to review her salary and come back with a recommendation to the board. He would like to have consistency with who participates in this discussion. There was discussion on creating a process that is consistent. Commissioner's McIntosh and Commissioner Kewish agreed to meet with EA Patti.

**Collective Bargaining Agreement 2018-2020:** Chief Bakken shared that the 2018-2020 Collective Bargaining Agreement has been ratified by members of Local 3876. The Board did not see a need to go into closed session. They recognized both Local President Hasbrook and Vice President Friese for their work with negotiations. Commissioner McIntosh requested the Board send a letter of thanks to both individuals.

Commissioner Severson made a motion to approve the CBA as presented; Commissioner Miller seconded the motion. Motion approved.

**Volunteer Captain John Piety:** Chief Bakken recognized Vol. Captain Piety for his ten years of service to our organization. He thanked him for all the work he has done and presented him with a certificate of appreciation and a 10 year pin.

**Upcoming Graduations:** We are excited to share that we have two members who are graduating in the coming days/weeks. ## **Body Armor Usage**

CATEGORY: Operations NUMBER: OPS - 30 April 2018

#### **REFERENCE**

North Mason Regional Fire Authority

#### **SCOPE**

North Mason Regional Fire Authority Personnel

#### **PURPOSE**

To establish guidelines for the storage and deployment of ballistic personal protective equipment (known herein as body armor), and what situations warrant its usage. Often times Fire and EMS personnel are called to scenes of violence. These scenes may either be inprogress or the circumstances unknown. In order to provide the greatest amount of protection to our personnel and increase their effectiveness while operating on scene, the Fire Authority will provide body armor and policies that aid in its usage.

#### **DEFINITIONS**

**Response to Violent Calls:** Incidents where the Fire Authority is called to Triage/Treat/Transport patient(s) due to actions of another person or persons acting as agents of violence.

Examples of this type of incident may include:

- 1) A shooting or stabbing where the perpetrator's location is unknown or the perpetrator has not been or cannot be detained.
- 2) Active shooter incident in a multitude of scenarios.
- A person wielding force such as a blunt (bat, etc.) or edged (knife, sword) weapon and the aggressor has not been or cannot be detained.
- 4) A bombing or threat of bombing.
- 5) Civil disturbance (riots or crowd dispersal incidents).
- 6) An individual is barricaded in a structure and there is the possibility of a weapon being involved.

**Hot Zone:** An area of an incident where the threat of violence against responders is direct, imminent and/or in progress. This would be any area that responders could face direct action from the perpetrator (whether they can see the perpetrator or not). This area is still under direct threat without anyone or anything impeding the act of violence.

**Warm Zone:** An area of an incident where the direct and/or imminent threat of violence against responders has been impeded by LE; and through coordination with LE, it has been determined that a warm zone has been established. In the warm zone, there exists a reasonable expectation of safety for responders. This could be due to LE's presence there – reducing the threat due to LE's ability to confront a threat directly (a protective perimeter formed by LE); or the person threatening the violence (even if they haven't been secured) has moved away and LE can isolate the threat at a distance from the warm zone. Responders should be accompanied by LE in the warm zone.

**Cold Zone:** An area of an incident where no threat of violence exists. This could be accomplished through a search of the area by LE and ensuring no threat exists; or, due to geographical or situational circumstances of cover/concealment where even though violent acts could still occur, they would be remote from this area. Responders are able to work unimpeded and without protection by LE officers or body armor.

**Rescue Task Force:** A group of *at least* 2 responders accompanied by *at least* one armed LE agent. This group can move into and out of the warm zone (together) for the purpose of packaging and extricating patients from the warm zone to a cold zone. LE agents accompany responders with the sole intent of protecting personnel from being targeted by violence. LE will do this by providing lethal or less-than-lethal interdiction should it become necessary.

#### **PROCEDURE**

#### A. Location and Storage of Body Armor:

- 1) Body armor will be located and deployed on "first out" response apparatus (e.g. Medic 21, Engine 21, Aid 27, Command 21, Chief's vehicles etc.) as necessary.
- 2) Confirming the location and readiness of the body armor will be the responsibility of the crew performing the rig checks on the applicable apparatus. They will place the body armor on the apparatus in a location they see fit to most effectively deploy the armor should they need it. The body armor will be part of the apparatus inventory and shall remain on the apparatus, in a state of readiness, for crew deployment (body armor will remain at the station in the event the apparatus is sent away for service, etc.).

#### B. When to Don/Utilize Body Armor:

Personnel shall don body armor during the following scenarios:

- 1) "Response to Violent Calls" as defined above.
- Any incident where Rescue Task Forces are utilized.

- 3) Response to "flagged addresses" where the reason for the flag is a history of violence toward first responders and the type of incident involves violence or it's feared the situation could become violent while personnel are on scene.
- 4) Any incident where the location of the perpetrator of violence cannot be determined and it's suspected that they still may be on scene or nearby.
- 5) At the discretion of the on-duty Officer, Acting Officer or responding Chief.
- 6) At the discretion of the response personnel, as they deem necessary to safeguard themselves or work more effectively in any given scenario.

It should be noted, that "staging for law enforcement" practices will still be followed, in order for LE to create a cold zone for responders whenever possible. The usage of body armor will not supplement having LE work to secure a hostile scene before Fire Authority units arrive. However, due to the circumstances on scene, if conditions of a warm zone are the best LE can create and exigent EMS practices are needed to save lives in jeopardy; body armor will be worn by responders on scene.

If body armor is not available to a responder (should they; 1) arrive by privately owned vehicle (POV), 2) arrive on apparatus not designated as "first out", 3) arrive on a "first out" apparatus but all body armor is in use by others) and that responder is comfortable working in the warm zone without body armor, their participation and activity in the warm zone will be at the discretion of the person in charge of EMS operations at the incident. The person in charge will work closely with LE to understand the risk posed to EMS personnel in the warm zone and weigh that risk against the exigent need for EMS providers in the warm zone.

## C. How to Wear Body Armor:

- 1) Donning and doffing procedural videos are available on the Fire Authority's training website.
- Personnel will wear body armor utilizing the front plate, back plate, and each side plate as provided. No modification of the body armor (removal or modification of the protective panels) will be allowed.
- 3) Body armor can be worn as an exterior garment over a t-shirt or sweatshirt, in a way that best fits the situation as determined by on scene personnel. This configuration allows the most versatility for quick donning/doffing as the situation dictates.
- 4) Body armor can be worn underneath a wildland brush jacket, if the wearer feels an exterior garment best- answers the situation (due to weather, to conceal the fact that the provider is wearing armor, etc.).
- 5) If a determination is made requiring personnel to wear Personal Protective Equipment aka "Bunker Gear" on scene for thermal protection and or immediately dangerous to life or health (IDLH) concerns, it is permissible to wear bunker gear over body armor. However, whenever any exterior garment is worn over body armor, personnel should be monitored more closely for heat exhaustion and/or fatigue. In

addition, rehab efforts should be employed. <u>At no time</u> shall personnel engage in interior structure firefighting operations while wearing body armor underneath their bunker gear.

6) Body armor shall not be worn by personnel to enter a body of water (with or without the use of a personal flotation device). Doing so can significantly alter a responders buoyancy which can lead to drowning.

#### D. When to Remove Body Armor:

Body Armor can be removed by response personnel:

- 1) Upon the conclusion of incident operations.
- 2) When it's determined that the threat to personnel has decreased to a point that they are working in a cold zone.
- 3) When personnel are removed from the incident area (such as in an ambulance enroute to a landing zone or hospital, or upon arrival at the hospital) and removal of the body armor would better facilitate providing EMS interventions to a patient(s). However, best judgement needs to be employed as to whether the body armor should remain on the apparatus and/or with the provider, in the event a return to the incident is necessary; or to retain the body armor on scene for other personnel to use.

If a member has donned body armor, but will be transitioning exclusively to a role outside of the warm zone (e.g. transporting patient(s) to the hospital, filling cold zone roles, etc.), they can transfer their body armor to other personnel who will be (remaining on scene, accomplishing triage or extrication of patients) working in the warm zone. These personnel NEED body armor, and should be afforded its usage.

#### E. Cleaning and Maintenance of Body Armor:

The manufacturer's recommendation for cleaning and maintenance will serve at the Fire Authorities guidelines for storage, cleaning, in-service lifespan, and discontinuation of service and disposal of the body armor.

If at any time, Fire Authority personnel have questions or concerns about anything contained herein, they shall contact their company officer (or otherwise direct supervisor) with these questions or concerns.

## Illegal Burning Reporting

CATEGORY: Operations NUMBER: OPS - 31 EFFECTIVE: May 2018

#### **REFERENCE**

WAC 173-425 (...-040 to -060) Mason County Title 9.48

#### SCOPE

North Mason Regional Fire Authority Personnel

#### **PURPOSE**

To determine when illegal burning activity is to be reported to the Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ) and Washington's Olympic Region Clean Air Authority (ORCAA) for enforcement action.

#### **DEFINITIONS**

**Land Clearing Burning**: The outdoor burning of trees, stumps, shrubbery or other natural vegetation with intent to clear land for commercial or residential purposes. This action requires a permit from Mason County and is not permitted in the Urban Growth Area (UGA) of Belfair.

**Residential Burning**: The outdoor burning of leaves, clippings, pruning's and other yard and gardening refuse originating on the lands immediately adjacent to and in close proximity to a human dwelling and burned by the property owner or their designee. This action is limited to a maximum pile size of four feet in a designated burning area meeting *Mason County Outdoor Burning Regulations* and may not occur in the UGA of Belfair.

**Recreational Fire**: Defined as cooking, camp, and ceremonial fires using charcoal or seasoned firewood that occurs in designated areas or on private property. Pile size is limed to three feet in diameter and two feet high. Fires used for debris disposal are not considered recreational fires. Recreational fires are allowed in the UGA of Belfair.

**Urban Growth Area (UGA)**: Mason County established areas where residential and land clearing fires are not allowed because of the population density and the public health impact of smoke from large fires.

**Natural Vegetation**: Defined as unprocessed plant material from herbs, shrubbery and trees, including grass, weeds, leaves, clippings, pruning, brush, branches, and roots.

#### **POLICY**

It is the policy of the North Mason Regional Fire Authority when a citizen is non-compliant with the burning regulations of Mason County and/or the citizen is burning illegal material, or their actions cause repeated visits for the same offence after Fire Authority education has been provided that complaints be properly documented and submitted to both the AHJ and ORCAA for enforcement action. Permits issued by the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) shall be enforced and monitored by DNR. If a permit is issued by DNR and burning conditions pose an immediate risk to life and/or property, the Fire Authority shall take appropriate action to mitigate any further hazard up to and including extinguishment. DNR shall be notified via dispatch anytime the Fire Authority responds to a DNR permitted fire.

#### **PROCEDURE**

**A. Reporting:** Fire Authority personnel will receive notification from MACECOM 911 or via telephone at any of the staffed stations. It is the responsibility of personnel to ensure that a run number is initiated and that the address is corrected at the close of the call. Oftentimes Authority members are dispatched to an approximate area of a suspected illegal burn. To ensure accurate reporting, the address must be updated with MACECOM 911 at the completion of the call using the following disposition.

"MACECOM, E-21 available from an illegal burn- corrected address: 460 NE Old Belfair Hwy. Owner to extinguish."

#### The following actions are reportable:

- 1) Repeat visits for any burning in the UGA.
- 2) Burning of illegal material.
- 3) Burning without a valid permit or non-compliance with permit conditions.
- 4) Burning during a burn ban.
- 5) Violation of Mason County Burning Regulations.
- **B. Documentation:** For the reportable actions listed above, the following items must be completed and an email sent to the Fire Prevention Captain or their designee to submit for enforcement action:
  - 1. Completed ERS Report with incident details on which type of call occurred.
  - 2. Reasoning for the referral.
  - 3. Documentation of the address and occupant.
  - 4. Pictures of the incident uploaded to ERS.
  - 5. Size and materials being burned.

- **C. Referral to AHJ:** Upon receipt of the completed documentation, the Fire Prevention Captain or their designee will review and determine if the incident will be forwarded to the AHJ. Incidents that meet the above criteria will be sent with a letter documenting the violation. This information will also be sent to ORCAA for enforcement action if the Fire Prevention Captain or their designee believes that the incident warrants such action including fines.
- **D.** Referral to ORCAA: Should the Fire Prevention Captain or their designee believe that all avenues for education have been exhausted and/or that the illegal burning that occurred warrants immediate enforcement action to include fines, reports and supporting documentation shall be forwarded to ORCAA in the appropriate manner.

It shall be the Fire Authority's primary objective to educate citizens on burning regulations in accordance with the *Mason County Outdoor Burning Regulations Guidelines*. It is also the Fire Authorities belief that "enforcement through education" generally results in a positive outcome for all parties than enforcement action alone. Complaints received will be forwarded based on merit and reviewed regarding the severity prior to submission.
