Capital Facilities Update: Chief Bakken provided a brief update on the partnership between Mason County and the Fire Authority. Chief will be meeting with the County Commissioners to formally present his proposal. We hope to have the letter of intent from the County soon if all goes well.

MRSC: Chief Bakken provided information on the participation in the MRSC Small Works Rosters Membership. They maintain a small works roster that we would use.
