# North Mason Regional Fire Authority (NMRFA) Meeting Minutes Via Telephone/Videoconference 10/13/2020

Meeting held via telephone/videoconference in accordance with Governor Jay Inslee's proclamation 20-28 issued on March 24, 2020

Meeting was called to order at 5:09 p.m. and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The meeting minutes from September 8 and September 15, 2020, were presented for approval.

Commissioner Severson moved to approve the meeting minutes with single amendment. Commissioner Quigley seconded the motion. Motion approved.

Financial vouchers were presented for review.

A motion was made by Commissioner Severson to approve the expense and payroll vouchers under BIAS 201001001 to 201001094 in the amount of \$592,727.75. Commissioner Kewish seconded the motion. Motion carried.

#### **ADMINISTRATION**

**COVID-19 Update:** Have seen an increase in cases state-wide. Within Mason County, recently had a significant outbreak at Fir Lane in Shelton. Mason County remains in Phase 3, Kitsap County in Phase 2. Many school districts are attempting to return to in-person learning to some capacity. North Mason will be holding in-person para-education/online learning for special needs students and students with limited access to internet. Continue to have limited access to testing in both Mason and Kitsap Counties (currently testing symptomatic patients only). Chief Bakken indicated local health department discussing expanding testing capabilities.

Washington State Fire Academy COVID-19 Update: Total of four students tested positive and academy cancelled. NMRFA had two students at the academy; upon notification of positives, the Authority immediately pulled both students from the academy, had them self-quarantine and get tested (prior to

returning home). Both students were tested again a week later as follow-up. Both students tested negative and are beyond the quarantine period.

**Blood Drive:** Filled all appointments for the September 25-26 Blood Drive. The HUB and Bloodworks NW have scheduled another drive for November.

**Fire Prevention Week Educational Videos:** Emergency Prevention Specialist Lacey Newman created 5 educational videos to celebrate Fire Prevention Week. One video shared to social media per day; all videos are available on our website.

**Bond Repayment:** When we initially requested the bond approval, we were seeking collection at \$.31; due to historical interest rates we will only be collecting at \$.25 or \$.26 which is great for our community members.

**Community Development:** Overton and Associates is a land developer preparing land behind McDonald's in Belfair to sell to a home builder/construction firm. The County is requiring two access points due to location and size. The secondary access identified by the developer does not meet the code requirements; County requiring sprinkler systems in all homes in lieu of secondary access. Developer currently pushing back on the County Commissioners; requesting to re-adopt International Fire Code which would recognize the secondary access and negate the sprinkler requirement. Chief Bakken monitoring closely; this may set a precedent for any future development in Mason County.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

**Headquarters Station Update:** Design continues to move along. Chief Bakken and Authority project team has had discussions with the architect Architects West, general contractor TRICO and owner representative Hill International regarding the progress of the project, as it seems we have strayed from the progressive design build process and have ongoing concerns regarding the status of the budget. Chief Bakken feels the meetings were successful in getting everyone back on the same page; meeting with all parties collectively tomorrow.

**Strategic Planning Steering Committee Update:** Chief Bakken gave a brief update; crews have provided feedback and the Authority will be working with CRT, volunteers and the community in the coming months. The input received from the crews has been given to the Steering Committee for review to identify overall themes.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

**Administrative Contract Review:** All administrative contracts have been sent to the Board for review. Chief Bakken provided and discussed his recommendations for consideration. Board approved request for Chief Bakken to draft formal MOU of recommendations for next meeting.

Meeting was called to order at 5:05 p.m. and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

A financial voucher was presented for review. The updated voucher is to close on the property purchase next door to Belfair Station 21; payment was previously approved, but the amount was reduced during the escrow process. The check approved last month has been cancelled and the updated voucher will be used for property closure.

A motion was made by Commissioner Kewish to approve the expense voucher under BIAS 201002001 in the amount of \$211,277.13. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

#### **FINANCIALS**

Chief Bakken presented the updated Budget Summary for October 2020. The Authority has received its first timber revenue payment for 2020; it is still unclear if there will be any back-payment or if we will continue to receive payment through the remainder of 2020. Also discussed the purchase of PSTrax program for rig checks; this program was not initially budgeted, so was purchased out of the fire equipment contingency fund. Briefly discussed the bond and construction funds; Chief Bakken indicated any payments for the headquarters station construction project from capital fund will be settled at the end of 2020.

Commissioner Quigley asked if there has been any feedback regarding assessed property values. Chief Bakken explained that he is aware of an increase throughout the county and discussed the potential impact on taxes for some residents.

**2021 Draft Budget:** Chief Bakken provided and discussed the 2021 budget draft. Explained will need to hold a budget hearing during the first part of November; Resolutions for approval at first or second Board meeting in November.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

**Strategic Planning Input Session:** Will move input session to next month; Executive Assistant Wassenaar will send out the feedback questions to Commissioners in advance to prepare for the meeting.

Administrative Contract Review: Discussed the administrative contract MOUs presented.

A motion was made by Commissioner Quigley to approve the Administrative Employee Contract MOUs as presented. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

### **COVID-19 Safety Guidelines**



### **Purpose**

The Department of Labor & Industries (L&I) requires employers to provide a safe and healthy workplace and to implement Governor Inslee's proclamation to ensure coronavirus prevention. The purpose of this Fact Sheet is to identify and communicate the guidelines for protecting the health of all staff and anyone who visits our facilities.

### Important Guidelines to Follow

Below are important guidelines personnel will follow on a daily basis...

#### Fire Station Life

- \* Maintain 6' physical separation at all times
- \* Wear a mask at all times.

#### Sleeping

- \* Single person per bedroom if at all possible
- \* If single person not possible (resident room and back bedroom can house two) maintain 6' physical separation with head-to-toe orientation and/or a physical barrier

#### Workout/PT

- \* Maintain 6' physical separation at all times
- \* No more than two personnel in the gym at one time
- \* Consider PT outside or stagger PT

#### Rig Checks

- \* Maintain 6' physical separation at all times
- \* If 6' is not possible, wear a mask

#### Sanitization

- \* Twice per day common areas sanitized, phones, doorknobs, light switches etc.
- \* Dorm rooms will be sanitized by off-going crews
- \* Rigs sanitized between runs

#### Worker/Visitor Logs

- \* Visitors are not allowed
- \* Non-personnel in any Authority station shall be documented
- \* Maintained in CrewSense/BIAS

# Shift Officer will be responsible for the COVID plan each day

- Ensure workers are screened for COVID—no signs of fever or illness
- Maintain a daily log to document procedures are being done



# Retention Committee Meeting Minutes 10/29/2020

Attendees: Chief Bakken, Assistant Chief Cooper, Volunteer Captain Sammons, Captain Reese, Captain Cleveland, Firefighter/Paramedic Cloud, Commissioners Severson and Miller, Executive Assistant Wassenaar

Last meeting in January prior to COVID-19

#### Training CRT and Volunteers:

- Has been on hold since we have been unable to engage volunteers due to Governor's proclamations and COVID-19
- The intent is to move forward with training programs for volunteers in 2021; currently attempting to navigate what those programs will look like with COVID-19
- All volunteers are put into the CRT program; following CRT training, volunteers will be pushed into specialized programs (driver/operator, fire academy, etc.)

#### **Employee Orientation Program:**

- Currently managed by Captains, Outreach Coordinator Robert Collamore, Executive Assistant McCormick, Assistant Chief Cooper
- Looking to expand the program and make the process more formal/consistent

#### **Career Development Programs:**

- Training identified throughout career 1 to 3 years, 3 to 5 years, Officer development, etc.
- Training is formalized through the Union's collective bargaining agreement, in order to identify financial support from the Authority

#### Mentoring and Coaching Programs:

• Captains and Lieutenants involved, as well as Chiefs/Assistant Chiefs for all subordinates

#### Performance Management:

- Current performance review systems have been in place for the last 3-4 years
- Annual evaluations include self-evaluation as well as evaluation by supervisor; once returned,
   Executive Assistant McCormick schedules a meeting between the two parties
- Discussion includes overall performance and goals/objectives which then assists with identifying training over the next year
- Lieutenants are currently in the process of refining this process
- New recruits are evaluated each shift throughout the probationary period; move to annual review once out of probationary period

#### Turnover:

- Discussed competing departments in the area, particularly Gig Harbor and the salary offered; NMRFA cannot compete
- Also predicted losing staff following the Lieutenant exam; the anticipated member did leave
- Officer workgroup has been created to identify and address some of the issues what the NMRFA
  culture is currently vs. where they want it to be; have begun to address these concerns including
  developing trust, onboarding process, training, etc.
- Tend to lose 2-3 year employees, but the senior/tenured list continues to grow annually
- Assistant Chief Cooper confirmed departments the size of NMRFA are facing similar turnover; the neighboring departments are unfortunately not comparable size

Final Thoughts – Commissioner Severson feels retention concerns have been addressed; the recent departures do not seem reflective of any internal issue or trend. Discussed Retention Committee meeting schedule; would like to meet semi-annually and as needed. Commissioner Miller indicated schedule can be confirmed at next Board meeting. Chief Bakken agreed a semi-annual schedule and as needed basis sounds appropriate. Captain Cleveland indicated he will also discuss with the Union body at the meeting later this evening, to confirm they have no concerns.

Chief Bakken stressed the importance of not taking for granted the long-term employees; most retention discussions focus on the 2-3 year employees which is important, but we cannot lose sight of the tenured employees as well

Meeting adjourned. Next meeting scheduled for April 15th, 5:00 pm

#### NORTH MASON REGIONAL FIRE AUTHORITY RESOLUTION 20-07

#### SUBSTANTIAL NEED RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS** the North Mason Regional Fire Authority Board of Fire Commissioners has met and considered its budget for the calendar year 2021; and

**WHEREAS** the Board of Commissioners has determined that the population of the District exceeds 10,000; and

**WHEREAS** the Board of Commissioners in the course of considering the budget for 2021 has reviewed all sources of revenue and examined all anticipated expenses and obligations; and

**WHEREAS** the Board of Commissioners has determined that, due to increased operating costs, for fire protection and emergency medical services and due to the need to fund capital improvements and purchases and other factors the Board of Commissioners finds that there is a substantial need to increase the regular property tax levy rate above the rate of inflation (Implicit Price Deflator);

**WHEREAS** because the current Implicit Price Deflator is less than one percent, RCW 84.55.0101 authorizes the Board, upon a finding of substantial need, to approve a Resolution by a super majority vote to establish a limit factor of up to 101%.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the North Mason Regional Fire Authority Board of Fire Commissioners that based on the substantial need of the District, the limit factor for the regular levy for taxes to be collected in calendar year 2021 shall be 101 per cent of the highest amount of regular property taxes that could have been lawfully levied in this taxing district in any year since 1985.
