North Mason Regional Fire Authority (NMRFA) Meeting Minutes 490 NE Old Belfair Hwy, Belfair WA Telephone/Videoconference Option 7/13/2021

Present: Commissioners Kelley McIntosh, Brooke Quigley, Paul Severson, Dan Kewish, Bob Miller; Executive Assistant Wassenaar; Chief Bakken

The meeting was held in-person with a telephone/videoconference option available.

Absent: Assistant Chief Cooper

Guests: Lea Sullivan

Meeting was called to order at 5:05 p.m. and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The meeting minutes from June 8 and June 15, 2021, were presented for approval.

Commissioner Severson moved to approve the meeting minutes as presented. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

FINANCIALS

Financial vouchers were presented for review.

A motion was made by Commissioner Quigley to approve the payroll and expense vouchers under BIAS 210702001 to 210702098 in the amount of \$722,569.93 and expense vouchers 210701001 to 210701002 in the amount of \$1,053,333.21. Commissioner Severson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

ADMINISTRATION

Mental Health Program Update: Chief Bakken introduced mental health provider Lea Sullivan to the Board. He explained that she maintains a private practice focusing primarily on first responders and is also a Chaplain. Lea is currently working two days per week at the Fire Authority to become acquainted with staff and learn the culture of the Fire Authority. Lea introduced herself and explained what she envisions for the program. Commissioner McIntosh stated that there is a county-wide Mason County Board of Fire Commissioners and they meet regularly to check-in. She invited Lea to attend the next meeting, scheduled for September 16 at 6:00 p.m. There was a continued group discussion regarding mental health needs throughout Mason County and first responder community as well as potential program components.

COVID-19: Chief Bakken explained that recent Governor's orders resulted in a majority statewide reopening at the end of June, which included authorization of in-person Board meetings. He also indicated that mask requirements will continue for the foreseeable future. There was a group discussion regarding vaccinations, COVID-19 variants and potential booster shot requirements.

Law Enforcement Policy Change: Chief Bakken indicated there are multiple pieces of legislation being implemented that impact law enforcement response procedures. He explained that the Fire Authority has historically relied on law enforcement to clear scenes and ensure the safety of firefighters for a multitude of scenarios including welfare checks and many behavioral health concerns. The Mason County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) wants to ensure that the relationship with the Fire Authority is not impacted by changes in procedure, but agencies will need to work in concert. Chief Bakken advised that based on recent discussions with MCSO, deputies will continue to respond and assess the situation, but if there is no criminal activity taking place, they will leave the scene. He indicated policies and procedures continue to develop.

Four-Shift Schedule Implementation: Chief Bakken explained that the schedule change will take place on September 18 or October 1. He advised that mock-scheduling scenarios will take place next week. He also indicated that we need to finalize who will be on which shift, and that announcement is planned for next week.

Captain Assessment: Chief Bakken advised that the assessment was completed last week, and he finished the interviews earlier this week. He stated that a final decision will be made by the middle of next week.

Apparatus Update: Chief Bakken provided a brief update, stating that Assistant Chief Cooper is currently in South Dakota inspecting the new fire engine that is being built. He advised that Assistant Chief Cooper will have pictures and videos to share at the Board meeting next week. Chief Bakken also indicated the new tender and aid unit are being built as we speak; the command vehicle has been delayed to August or September due to the lack of availability of microchips.

Mason County Burn Ban Status: Chief Bakken stated that there is a full burn ban in effect.

OLD BUSINESS

Strategic Planning: Chief Bakken advised that a Strategic Plan draft has been completed and is awaiting review and approval by the Steering Committee. The committee is scheduled to meet next week. Following approval by the Steering Committee, the draft will be ready to present to the Board.

Headquarters Station Project Update: Chief Bakken indicated that he did a walk-through tour today and there will be a discussion regarding the Quality Control process next week with TRICO.

NEW BUSINESS

Maggie Lake: Chief Bakken advised the Maggie Lake station is currently leased from Don Cady who is in the process of transferring executorship to his family and wants to be sure there are no issues with future lease agreements for the station. Chief Bakken stated that he will have additional information to provide by the next Board meeting.

Public Comment: None

GOOD OF THE ORDER

Commissioner Quigley requested a discussion regarding water supply. Commissioner Severson explained that any new development in the area is required to go through Mason County. The request is also reviewed at the state level by public health who makes the final determination. Chief Bakken stated that he can invite Dale from the Belfair Water District to attend an upcoming Board meeting.

With no further business Commissioner McIntosh moved to adjourn the meeting at 6:30 p.m.

ADMINISTRATION

Headquarters Station Update: TRICO Construction Superintendent Mark Knudson provided a brief update on construction progress of the new fire station as well as the schedule moving forward. He stated that the project is currently on schedule and anticipates the exterior of the building to be complete by the end of September. Chief Bakken and Mark Knudson discussed the appropriate process for scheduling site visits; interested individuals will reach out to Administrative Assistant Sarah Morgan who will provide notice to TRICO.

OLD BUSINESS

Strategic Planning: Chief Bakken advised that the Steering Committee Meeting scheduled for this week was cancelled but the group will reschedule before August. He still anticipates the final draft being presented to the Board in August.

Citizen's Advisory Committee (CAC): Commissioner Quigley provided a brief update. She advised that the CAC would like to tour the headquarters fire station site at the next meeting. Because that meeting is scheduled for October, the time may need to adjusted to allow sufficient daylight.

NEW BUSINESS

Policy Review – Vape Free Workplace, Equip/Fac-14.1: Vaping is strictly prohibited anywhere that tobacco use is prohibited, including all locations within buildings leased or controlled by the Authority, at any site where training occurs while training is being conducted, at all emergency operating scenes, and in any Authority owned, leased or controlled vehicle.

Motion made by Commissioner Quigley to approve the new policy Vape Free Workplace, Equip/Fac-14.1. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Maggie Lake: Chief Bakken advised the Maggie Lake station is currently leased from Don Cady who is in the process of transferring executorship to his family and wants to be sure there are no issues with future lease agreements for the station. Chief Bakken stated that unfortunately he does not have any further update to provide, as Mr. Cady has had some recent health issues.

Trails End Lake: Commissioner McIntosh and Chief Bakken discussed the upcoming closure of Trails Road scheduled for July 26 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Chief Bakken indicated he will need to determine if emergency traffic will be able to get through and will contact supporting agencies for response if necessary.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish guidelines and procedures for the reimbursement of reasonable and necessary expenses incurred by persons authorized to travel for Authority-related business. Eligible expenses include registration, lodging, meals and/or incidental expenses.

POLICY

It is the policy of the North Mason Regional Fire Authority to reimburse Authority members for reasonable and necessary expenses incurred during approved work-related travel. Personnel seeking reimbursement should incur the lowest reasonable travel expenses and exercise care to avoid impropriety or the appearance of impropriety. Reimbursement is allowed only when reimbursement has not been, and will not be, received from other sources. If a circumstance arises that is not specifically covered in this travel policy, then the most conservative course of action shall be taken.

- 1. **Eligibility.** Individuals authorized to receive travel and other incidental expense reimbursement, within budgetary restraints, include:
 - 1.1. Fire Authority employees.
 - 1.2. Elected Fire Authority Commissioners.
 - 1.3. Volunteers, when authorized by the Fire Chief or his/her designee.
- 2. **Authorization and Responsibility.** The Fire Chief or his/her designee will be responsible for review and authorization of all requests for travel and associated expenses.
 - 2.1. Individuals should verify that planned travel is eligible for reimbursement and request approval prior to making any travel arrangements. All requests for travel shall include the following:
 - 2.1.1. Documentation confirming that the travel pertains to official Authority business; and

- 2.1.2. When available, a travel itinerary and/or printed material detailing estimated travel expenses.
- 2.2. The Fire Chief may authorize reimbursement for non-mandatory attendance at jobrelated seminars, conferences, conventions or training, at a rate lower than that outlined in this policy.
 - 2.2.1. Prior to travel authorization, the Fire Chief and Fire Authority member shall mutually agree, in writing, on the reduced reimbursement rate(s).
- 3. Registration Costs. When authorized by the Fire Chief or his/her designee, the Authority shall reimburse an individual or prepay registration costs for any meeting, conference, convention or work session required for official Fire Authority business. The Authority may also reimburse an individual for educational courses including seminars, classes, trainings, etc., when the course is deemed beneficial to the Fire Authority and pertains to an Authority purpose.
- 4. **Transportation Costs.** When authorized by the Fire Chief or his/her designee, the Authority shall reimburse an individual for the actual and necessary costs of transportation, including but not limited to airfare, rail transportation and rental vehicles.
 - 4.1. Travel reimbursement shall be provided for the following:
 - 4.1.1. The method of transportation and route most advantageous to the Authority, considering the cost of transportation and other travel expenses.
 - 4.1.2. The cost of coach class fare for a given mode of travel, unless less expensive fares are unavailable.
 - 4.1.3. Necessary taxi, bus, subway, metro, ferry, airport shuttle or other public transportation costs.
 - 4.2. When multiple Fire Authority members are traveling to the same event, the Authority will authorize reimbursement for the minimum number of vehicles required to transport the employees.
 - 4.2.1. Fire Authority Commissioners may drive separate from other employees.
 - 4.2.2. Fire Authority members driving an Authority vehicle shall follow the regulations outlined in the "Use of Authority Vehicles" policy, Equip/Fac-18.
 - 4.3. **Rental Vehicles.** The Fire Authority will pay for approved use of a rental vehicle. Drivers must adhere to the rental requirements, and restrictions must be followed. When authorizing rental vehicles, the following conditions apply:
 - 4.3.1. The individual shall obtain a Government rate whenever possible.

- 4.3.2. The individual shall rent the least costly vehicle that adequately carries the person(s) and equipment required for conducting Fire Authority business.
- 4.3.3. The Fire Authority will not provide reimbursement for the cost of vehicle insurance offered by the vehicle rental agency.
- 4.3.4. Reimbursement for gas expenses may be requested by submitting reimbursement receipts to the Fire Authority. The Fire Chief or his/her designee may authorize a travel expense advance for gas expenses if there is a potential hardship.
- 4.4. **Personal Vehicles.** Use of a privately owned vehicle shall be reimbursed at a rate not to exceed the current mileage reimbursement rate established by the Washington State Office of Financial Management (OFM).
 - 4.4.1. Reimbursement shall be limited to portal-to-portal distances, unless otherwise authorized.
 - 4.4.2. Regular roundtrip commute is not reimbursable and shall be deducted from the mileage reimbursement if travel occurs during a regularly assigned workday.
 - 4.4.3. The Fire Authority's automobile insurance policy shall be the primary coverage.
- 5. **Lodging Costs.** The cost of overnight lodging (room rate and tax only) will be reimbursed at a rate not to exceed the current lodging rate established by the Washington State Office of Financial Management (OFM).
 - 5.1. The Fire Chief or his/her designee may authorize reimbursement at a rate higher than that outlined by OFM. Reimbursement will be subject to prior approval and limited to reasonable, single occupancy or standard business room rates. When the hotel or motel is the conference or convention site, reimbursement will be limited to the conference rate.
 - 5.2. To be eligible for reimbursement of overnight lodging costs, the following conditions apply:
 - 5.2.1. The event must be located more than seventy-five (75) miles from the individual's primary workplace.
 - 5.2.1.1. Exceptions to this restriction may be approved by the Fire Chief or his/her designee when the event has mandatory evening functions.
 - 5.2.2. The individual shall maintain overnight travel status.

- 5.2.3. The individual shall obtain a Government rate whenever possible.
- 5.3. If two (2) individuals share a room, each person shall submit a reimbursement request for one-half (1/2) of the double occupancy charge, plus tax.
- 5.4. Lodging costs from the night the authorized event ends may be eligible for reimbursement when no reasonably priced and timely return transportation is available.
- 6. **Meals, Per Diem and Incidental Expenses.** The Fire Authority will provide reimbursement for per diem rate and meals for partial days of travel. The Fire Authority will only reimburse meal costs for the Authority member(s) authorized for the travel event. The cost of meals and incidental expenses will be reimbursed at a rate not to exceed the current meal rate established by the Washington State Office of Financial Management (OFM).
 - 6.1. The Fire Authority may reduce the per diem rate under the following circumstances:
 - 6.1.1. For meals included in a registration fee, airfare or other Authority expense, the Fire Authority will reduce the per diem meal and incidental rate by the fixed allowance for the respective meal.
 - 6.1.2. For continental breakfast included in lodging, the Fire Authority will reduce the per diem meal and incidental rate by the fixed allowance for the breakfast meal, unless the continental breakfast offered includes no more than cereal, pastry and beverages.
 - 6.2. The Authority may reimburse employees or pay directly for meal expenses at staff retreats, trainings and Fire Authority events when the work being performed is directly related to Authority business and is authorized by the Fire Chief or his/her designee.
 - 6.3. **Non-Reimbursable Meal and Refreshment Costs.** The Fire Authority will not reimburse meal and refreshment costs when:
 - 6.3.1. Included in another Authority expense, regardless of whether the person partakes in the meal or refreshment.
 - 6.3.2. Incurred for recreational or social events such as office, going away and retirement parties, or other personalized social events.
 - 6.3.3. A violation of the State Constitution, Article VIII, Section 7, when a gift of public funds would occur.
 - 6.3.4. A purchase of alcoholic beverage(s) is made.
- 7. **Other Reimbursable Expenses.** The Fire Authority may reimburse essential miscellaneous expenses related to business travel. Original receipts are required for all

miscellaneous expenses. Miscellaneous expenses include:

- 7.1. Parking.
- 7.2. Bridge and road tolls.
- 7.3. Airport baggage fees.
- 7.4. Business expenses: faxes, photocopies, Internet charges and business telephone calls.
- 8. **Non-Reimbursable Expenses.** The Fire Authority will not reimburse the following ineligible expenses:
 - 8.1. Expenses incurred without prior approval from the Fire Authority, unless an emergency occurred preventing prior approval.
 - 8.2. Travel and miscellaneous expenses not authorized under this policy.

- 8.5.16. Excess costs and additional travel expenses as a result of taking an indirect route or a delayed return trip for personal preference or convenience, except when an indirect route or delay reduces the Fire Authority's total cost.
- 8.5.17. Travel paid for by any other organization.
- 8.5.18. Travel expenses when a District, County, state or federal law or policy designates another source of reimbursement.
- 9. Travel Expense Advances. The Fire Authority will attempt to minimize the need for travel expense advances to members, Commissioners and volunteers by pre-paying for travel arrangements and using a Fire Authority credit card for travel related expenses. This does not apply to per diem expense advances.
 - 9.1. Travel expense advances are subject to the following conditions:
 - 9.1.1. The Fire Chief or his/her designee must provide authorization for the Fire Authority to issue a travel expense advance.
 - 9.1.2. The authorized amount of such an advance shall not exceed the amount of anticipated reimbursable expenses.
 - 9.1.3. Travel expense advances shall only cover an individual's reimbursable expenses incurred while conducting official Fire Authority business.
 - 9.1.4. For per diem.
 - 9.2. The individual receiving advanced travel funds shall:
 - 9.2.1. Submit, prior to travel, a Fire Authority travel request and per diem form(s); and
 - 9.2.2. Provide all travel-related receipts to the Fire Authority within ten (10) days of the last day of travel; and

- 9.2.3. When submitting receipts, return any unexpended portion of such advance to the Fire Authority.
- 10. Expense Reimbursement Claim. Other than for travel expense advances, individuals requesting reimbursement for expenses must submit reimbursement receipts to the Fire Authority. Only authorized travel expenses and expenses identified in this policy will be reimbursed.
- 11. **Repayment of Unauthorized Reimbursement.** Should an audit or subsequent review of travel expense reimbursements determine that travel expenses were reimbursed outside of the guidelines outlined in this policy, the Fire Authority will seek repayment of expenses from the individual who was reimbursed.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish guidelines and procedures for the reimbursement of reasonable and ordinary and necessary expenses incurred by persons authorized to travel for Authority-related business. Eligible expenses include of persons authorized to travel and for registration, lodging, meals, and/or incidental expenses incurred while away from home in performance of Authority related business and for other business related meal and incidental expenses.

POLICY

It is the policy of the North Mason Regional Fire Authority to reimburse Authority members for reasonable and necessary expenses incurred during approved work-related travel. Personnel seeking reimbursement should incur the lowest reasonable travel expenses and exercise care to avoid impropriety or the appearance of impropriety. Reimbursement is allowed only when reimbursement has not been, and will not be, received from other sources. If a circumstance arises that is not specifically covered in this travel policy, then the most conservative course of action shall be taken.

- <u>Eligibility.</u> <u>PersonsIndividuals</u> authorized to receive expense, travel and other incidental expense reimbursement, within budgetary restraints, include:
- 1. REIMBURSEMENT AUTHORIZATION

Persons authorized to receive expense, travel and other incidental expense reimbursement within budgetary restraints:

- 1.1. Fire Authority employees.
- 1.2. E and elected Fire Authority Commissioners.

TRAVEL AUTHORIZATION

When authorizing the use of a private automobile the Authority shall reimburse mileage at a rate not to exceed the current mileage reimbursement rate established by the Washington State Office of Financial Management, http://www.ofm.wa.gov/resources/travel.asp.Use of a privately owned vehicle shall be reimbursed at a rate not to exceed the current mileage reimbursement rate established by the Washington State Office of Financial Management (OFM).

- 4.4.1. Reimbursement shall be limited to portal-to-portal distances, unless otherwise authorized.
- 4.4.2. Regular roundtrip commute is not reimbursable and shall be deducted from the mileage reimbursement if travel occurs during a regularly assigned workday.

LODGING COSTS

1. Lodging Costs. The cost of overnight lodging (room rate and tax only) will be reimbursed at a rate not to exceed the current lodging rate established by the Washington State Office of Financial Management (OFM).

COVID-19 Vaccination

Proclamation by the Governor 21-14: COVID-19 Vaccination Requirement Legal Opinions Provided by Attorney Brian Snure; August 10 and 12, 2021

SCOPE

All Authority Health Care Providers.

PURPOSE

In accordance with Washington State Proclamation 21-14 issued by the Governor of the State of Washington, signed and sealed with the official seal of the state of Washington on August 9, 2021, the Authority is prohibited from permitting a Health Care Provider to engage in work for the Authority as an employee, contractor or volunteer after October 18, 2021, if the Health Care Provider has not been fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and provided proof thereof. In addition, Proclamation 21-14 prohibits Authority wildland firefighters from participating in firefighting activities that arise from a Washington State mobilization or Washington State Department of Natural Resources request for fire suppression support, if they are not fully vaccinated against COVID-19 by October 18, 2021. The purpose of this policy is to establish the procedures the Authority will follow to comply with the legal requirements of Proclamation 21-14.

DEFINITIONS

1. **COVID-19.** Coronavirus disease 2019, caused by the virus known as severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2).

2. Health Care Provider.

- 2.1. Authority employees or volunteers with credentials issued by the Washington State Department of Health including EMR, EMT, AEMT and Paramedics.
- 2.2. Authority employees or volunteers who are permitted by law to provide health care services in a professional capacity without holding a credential.
- 2.3. Authority employees or volunteers working in any Health Care Setting.
- Health Care Setting. Any public or private setting that is primarily used for the delivery of inperson health care services to people, including but not limited to mobile clinics or other vehicles where health care is delivered, except as specifically exempted in Proclamation 21-14.

4. Fully Vaccinated Against COVID-19. A person is fully vaccinated against COVID-19 two (2) weeks after receiving the second dose in a two (2)-dose series COVID-19 vaccine (Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna) authorized for emergency use, licensed or otherwise approved by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) or two (2) weeks after receiving a single-dose COVID-19 vaccine (Johnson & Johnson (J&J)/Janssen) authorized for emergency use, licensed or otherwise approved by the FDA.

POLICY

All Authority Health Care Providers, volunteer and career, are required to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and provide proof of full vaccination to the Authority no later than October 18, 2021. Because an individual is considered fully vaccinated against COVID-19 two (2) weeks after receiving the second dose in a two (2)-dose series COVID-19 vaccine or two (2) weeks after receiving a single-dose COVID-19 vaccine, the final dose must be administered no later than October 4, 2021.

Vaccinations are not required for employees and volunteers who are not Health Care Providers (see Definitions above), including Administrative and Executive Assistants and the Board of Commissioners, except when contracted by the Washington State Patrol (WSP) or Department of Natural Resources (DNR) for wildfire suppression services.

PROCEDURE

- 1. Acceptable Proof of Full Vaccination Against COVID-19. Personal attestation is not an acceptable form of verification of COVID-19 vaccination. Authority Health Care Providers, volunteer and career, must provide proof of full vaccination against COVID-19 by supplying the Authority's Executive Assistant of Finance, Human Resources and Records with one of the following:
 - 1.1. Centers for Disease Control (CDC) COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card or photo of the card;
 - 1.2. Documentation of vaccination from a health care provider or electronic health record; or
 - 1.3. State immunization information system record.
- 2. **New Authority Health Care Providers.** Any Health Care Provider, career or volunteer, joining the Fire Authority after October 4, 2021, shall be required to provide proof of full vaccination against COVID-19 to the Authority before he/she will be eligible to provide health care services.
- 3. Exemptions from Vaccine Requirement.
 - 2.1. An individual is not required to get vaccinated against COVID-19 if he/she is entitled under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (Title VII), the Washington Law Against Discrimination (WLAD) or any other applicable law to a disability-related reasonable accommodation.
 - 2.1.1. The individual requesting the exemption must provide the Authority with

documentation from an appropriate health care or rehabilitation professional authorized to practice in the state of Washington stating that the individual has a disability that necessitates an accommodation and the probable duration of the need for the accommodation.

- 2.2. An individual is not required to get vaccinated against COVID-19 if he/she is entitled to a sincerely held religious belief accommodation.
 - 2.2.1. The individual requesting the exemption must provide the Authority with a statement regarding the way in which the requirements of Proclamation 21-14 conflict with the religious observance, practice, or belief of the individual.
 - 2.2.2. The Authority must document that the request for an accommodation has been made and include the statement provided by the individual.
- 3. **Violations.** Infractions of this policy are subject to discipline using standard progressive disciplinary measures up to and including termination. Additionally, failure to comply with the requirements of Proclamation 21-14 may result in criminal penalties pursuant to RCW 43.06.220(5).

This policy is subject to change as new recommendations and guidelines become available.
